Intrinsic to the show are the people of Hull, whether as participants, such as amateur dancers and street performers (circus entertainers, parkour, jugglers) or as the audience who contribute to the

development of the show. Each day the performance ends at a point that keeps the audience wondering what's next in the story, and postcards will be handed out by the performers that encourage passers-by to engage with the making of the story via social media. The narration will therefore unfold from everyday life in Hull; from the people, locations and life around them, bringing them on a creative journey of their devising and exploring what the city means to them in a local and global context.
