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Our Heritage

The first ever Pride in Hull was in 2002, it was held in Queens Gardens and was really well attended and appreciated by our local community. Since then, there have been many iterations, moving to West Park and more recently onto Baker Street.

For the two most recent Prides, a community group was formed and that has developed into a not-for-profit charity. 2017 will be the third event produced and managed by Pride in Hull – Hull LGBT+ Community Pride. The group has been at pains to ensure that its objects around inclusivity are fully met, and, whilst pride events are not for all, the team works hard to provide full representation for all community members.

PIONEERING PRIDE

A number of trustees went on a fact-finding mission to Rotterdam intent on seeing how our Euro peers provided care and support to their own community. Those findings have informed our process and it is our intention to include many of the findings into our community offer within the remit of our charitable status.
