About 2097: We Made Ourselves Over

2097: We Made Ourselves Over is a science fiction event which engages its audience in a story which is citywide. Diverse communities across Hull and Aarhus will work in partnership with the artists to develop a speculative future for the city employing writing, mobile gaming and film.

The work will consist of an app for smartphones, intimate face to face encounters with players across the city, two live experiences in Hull (UK City of Culture 2017) and Aarhus (European Capital of Culture 2017) and a series of extraordinary films, We Made Ourselves Over invites audiences to come together to play, to explore and to dream of new futures.

Blast Theory are looking for enthusiastic volunteers to help on the shoot of the 5 sci-fi short films in July 2017. These films will be released online and screened across Hull in October 2017.

Location Marshal (2 at any given time):

Dates: approx. 5 days between 3^{ra} – 23^{ra} July) Hours: 6am – 6pm *One day of shooting will finish at 12am

Volunteers to act as ambassadors and guides on the Hull location shoots. Volunteers will help keep the shoot on its tight schedule by welcoming on-lookers and showing them where they can watch the filming from. Volunteers will also act as ambassadors for 2097: We Made Ourselves Over by answering questions about the project in general, and asking local spectators about their thoughts for the future. Tasks:

- Maintaining lock-off areas around the set
- Maintaining quiet and order on-set amongst spectators during takes
- Chatting with passers-by about what's going on
- Informing members of the public about the project and explaining how they can get involved

Role would suit someone with:

- Good communication skills
- Good stamina, as you will be constantly talking to people during the shift
- · An interest in film-making

Volunteers to be extras in a mass crowd-scene, set in the year 2097. Volunteers will receive a brief of what to wear and may also be provided with specific costume pieces. Tasks:

Appear in the background of scenes shot on location in Hull
